Guideline for Bio (125 words or less in length)

The goal of the presenter bio is to provide GBA with a high-level view of the presenter's career and major business/career accomplishments.

- Full name, current job title and organization's name
- Description of your role in the organization and the services it provides
- Highlights from your career as it relates to your current position
- Degrees, certifications, awards, honors and authored publications
- If the Conference Committee selects your presentation, GBA will notify you no later than **November 11, 2016**.
- Selected speakers will work with GBA staff to finalize their presentation summaries by **December 9, 2016**.
- Selected speakers are required to submit their FINAL electronic presentation no later than **March 3, 2017**.

Evaluation Criteria

The GBA Conference Committee will evaluate abstracts on overall topic quality, relevance to the GBA audience and conference theme, practical application of material, and speaker qualifications.
