- Highlights from your career as it relates to your current position
- Degrees, certifications, awards, honors and authored publications
- GBA will notify selected abstract presenters by Friday, December 14, 2018.
- Selected presenters must provide final session description by Friday, December 21, 2018.
- Selected presenters must submit final electronic presentation by Friday, March 1, 2018.

Evaluation Criteria

The GBA Program Committee will evaluate abstracts on overall topic quality, relevance to the GBA audience and conference theme, practical application of material, and speaker qualifications.
