

WHEN YOU GO:

- 1. Schedule classroom visits well in advance with both the teacher whose classroom you'll be visiting, and the school principal.
- Review the content of the presentation with the teacher. Discuss an appropriate length of time for your visit and visual aids you will be bringing. Be flexible with requests of the teacher to modify any aspect of your visit.
- 3. Provide the names of all visitors who will be in attendance and do not deviate from the list of approved attendees without prior approval.
- 4. Review the school's visitor code of conduct policy in advance. Usually this is available online from the school or school system website, but it's a good idea to ask the teacher and/or principal if there are any additional considerations.
- 5. All attendees should bring with them a valid photo ID.
- 6. Arrive early to the school to allow time for sign-in and badging. Enter only through the front door. The entrance may be equipped with a security system; if so, ring the bell, look into the camera and await further instructions.
- Once you enter, proceed directly to the main office. They will usually have a system for signing in visitors and issuing a visitor's badge or sticker. Keep the badge visible on you at all times while on school property.
- 8. Visitors to a school may require a full time escort. Be mindful of this and comply with any school-specific escort policy.
- Video/audio recording and photography is prohibited while on school grounds. This includes posting to any social media platform.
- 10. Stay only for the agreed upon length of time and remain in the agreed upon classroom or other building location only for a reasonable length of time.
- 11. Minimize disruptions to the learning environments and avoid engaging students beyond the limits of the agreed-upon classroom visit without the express permission from the classroom teacher or school administration.
